We would like to inform you that a tentative agreement is reached between The International Longshoremen's Association (ILA) and United States Maritime Alliance (USMX). This tentative agreement is reached on all items of the negotiation for a new six-year Master Contract, preventing any work stoppages as of 16 January, and is yet to be ratified by both sides.
